OBJECTIVES OF THE SESSION

- Validate GradExpert performance using your own lumber
- Compare results with your current grading solution
- Quantify the potential value uplift
- Establish a clear ROI and payback scenario

We can process approximately 200 boards per day, and larger volumes can be accommodated over multiple test days.

LUMBER REQUIREMENTS

To ensure meaningful and accurate results, lumber must meet the following criteria.

Lumber must be representative of your production.

Lumber can be tested either green or dry, and in either rough or planed condition. If the lumber originates outside Canada, it must be kiln-dried (KD) and heat-treated (HT) to comply with Canadian import regulations.

Lumber must be untrimmed and unstamped.

Each board must be numbered on the end.

Multiple board items (dimensions/grades) can be tested during the same session.

Lumber may be pre-graded by your Quality Control team to accelerate analysis.

Maximum dimensions:

- Thickness: 6 in.
- Width: 32 in.
- Length: 16 ft.

If possible, provide results from your current grading solution for comparison.

Use non-test lumber for the top and bottom layers of each package shipped.

Each package must be properly wrapped to keep the lumber clean during transportation.

DOCUMENTATION AND MATERIAL REQUIRED

(minimum 2 weeks prior to testing)

To prepare the testing environment, Comact must receive:

- Grade rules
- Price list
- Saw pattern information
- Current grading solution output (if available)
- Lumber delivered to Mirabel

WHAT YOU WILL RECEIVE

At the end of the test, you will receive:

- Detailed grade mix comparison
- Value recovery analysis
- Performance summary report
- Estimated ROI and payback calculation

This ensures you leave with clear, decision-ready data aligned with your production reality.
